#### **Participating:**

- □ Each NSO has the right to participate with (2) rovers who aged (18-25) years (male only). We expect more than (100) participants from more than 50 countries around the world.
- ☐ There is a chance for Omani young leaders to participate too.

### **Abut Program**

(The event contains three stages)

- □ Stage One: (4<sup>th</sup> -6<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2013)
  - Arrival date (4<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2013) in Muscat and moving to the hotel.
  - Opening ceremony (Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2013).
- □ Stage Two: (6<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2013)
  - (Friday and Saturday: 6<sup>th</sup> -7<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2013) the participants will be divided into (4) groups. Each group will move to one of Oman governorates (Muscat Aldakhiliyah South A'Sharqiyah Musandam). Each group will visit the most important places in that governorate especially the tourism, cultural and heritage places. At this stage the accommodation is in hotels or stadiums (rooms).
  - On Sunday the 8<sup>th</sup> all groups moves to Dhofar governorate.
- □ Stage three: (8<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2013)
  - Arrival to Dhofar on Monday the 9<sup>th</sup> in Jabal Ashor Scouts Camp. Which is around 1000 km far from Muscat. Accommodation is in tents.
  - Four days in Dhofar will contains:
    - ✓ Visit places which listed in world heritage UNISCO list.
    - ✓ Groups show their reports and pictures about their visit to the different governorates.
    - ✓ Cultural seminars.
    - ✓ A seminar about Environment and Biological diversity.
    - ✓ Entertaining and sport activities.
    - ✓ Countries folklore.
    - ✓ Countries Exhibition.
    - ✓ Campfire.
